At this time of year, we go into the process of **assigning pupils to their 2019 classes**. This is a rigorous process, and once it is completed we are not easily able to make any adjustments.

Therefore we aim to get it right.

To help us out for next year, we ask that you **let us know if your child will not be at Everglade School next year**. It helps us to know this in advance, so if your plans are set, please let us know.

If you wish to discuss your child's progress and needs for next year, please contact me for this. We don't get into requesting specific teachers; this is about what will help your child as they move into next year. Sometimes that information is useful when we plan classes.

If you wish to discuss your child's needs, please do so by 23 November. After this date, classes are virtually settled.

Starting on Monday, there will be some **minor construction work** taking place at different parts of the school. This is not a major project, rather a bunch of small improvements to paths and entranceways. What will be a bit tricky at times is the **'work site access.'** **This will restrict parking in the ramp area leading up to the big bin, and carrying on down behind Rooms 5-8.** Signage will show this clearly from Monday, and we ask those who park at school to be aware of these restrictions, and follow the messages on the signs.

You have probably read or heard on the news that primary teachers have voted to take **industrial action**. In the Auckland region, this is set down for **Monday 12 November**. There is a very small likelihood that his action will be averted; however, it is much more likely that the strike action will be taking place.

What does this mean for Everglade School?

It is a **Board of Trustees decision** as to how the school responds to industrial action. They will consider the available options and make a call on what will happen at Everglade School on 12 November. This will be communicated to all families at the earliest possible opportunity.

A couple of dates to note:

- ★ Thursday 29 November Twilight Festival

These are both 'evening' events. Check details when they come out.

In the coming weeks we have scheduled **Athletics Sports Days**. These are held as two events:

- Junior Athletics Day (Rooms 1-15)
- Senior Athletics Day (Rooms 16-23)
